CHE BUI FARM

Many Honolulu friends and acquaintances are mourning the death of Che Bui Farm who was lost in the waters off Kalaupapa, Molokai, last Tuesday. The Star-Bulletin on Saturday carried the story of the death of Mr. Farm, who was born in Honolulu on December 4, 1887, and educated in local schools, and later became prominent in business. In recent years he had been in the real estate and rental business.

He went to Molokai on Friday, April 6, to visit the leper settlement, traveling aboard the 65 foot sampan Kalawao, operated by the territorial board of hospitals and settlements.

The sampan was caught in a bad Kona storm and ran aground on a reef near Kalaupapa Friday night. The sampan and her cargo were lost but all of the persons aboard survived.

On Tuesday, after visiting at Kalaupapa, Mr. Farm went fishing on the rocks along the shore near the leper settlement. He was caught by a giant wave and hurled from the rocks into the sea. His body was not recovered.

Funeral services will be announced later.
