

FAMILY OF CAPTAIN ALEXANDER ADAMS

Captain Alexander Adams became a great friend of King Kam I who put him in charge of the King's fleet, consisting of nine square riggers and fifteen smaller craft. He went to Canton, China, with a cargo of sandalwood on the "Kaahumanu", owned also by Kam I. He was appointed by Kam I as first regular pilot for Honolulu Harbor which he held for forty years. -"Friend" Dec. 1871 Builders of Hawaii."

He was the designer of the Hawaiian flag. When he arrived in China, that government demanded that the vessel of which he was the skipper be also identified with a flag. Not having one Captain Alexander Adams put the British union jack together with the American flag and produced the first Hawaiian flag with the Union Jack in the upper left corner and the stripes of the American flag.

Captain Adams introduced many fruit trees, including mangoes, from China North and South America.

His companion was John Young, close advisor of King Kam I. He and Young influenced King Kam II to permit American missionaries to land in 1820. - Advertiser, 3 Jun 1896.

He aided Kam I in 1817 in expelling the Russians from Kauai. -Ibid.

Captain Adams was born in Arbroth, Forfarshire, Scotland 27 Dec 1780; and died in Honolulu 27 Oct 1871.

His father was the Earl of Fyfe. He came to Hawaii in 1811. He was educated in England. He was captain of a ship and a trader. He was engaged in the sandalwood trade for the Hawaiian monarch in the early days. He was pilot of Honolulu Harbor for many long years. He served also as the King's advisor.

✧ Isaac Keaumoku Adams, son of Alexander Adams and Sally Kaniaulono Davis, was born in Honolulu in 1817. He was educated in Hawaii. He was one of the King's attendants (hanai). He married Kealiiopunui Kalanikaukeha, a pure Hawaiian, and had five children: Sally Kaniaulono (Agnes Kauana Kanahale's grandmother), Alexander, David, Agnes, and Isaac.

Sally Kaniaulono Adams (Sanford) was born at Niu, Oahu, 1883, and was educated in the English schools in Honolulu. She later married Daniel Sanford, a Caucasian, in Honolulu and had six children: Abbie (McGuire), Harriette, George Hueu (Agnes Kauana Kanahale's father), Daniel, Isaac, and William. William died in infancy. Mr. Sanford died and Sally married Samuel Kaeo, a pure Hawaiian and had two children: William and Lillian.

Daniel Sanford came from Boston, Mass., and was a cabinet-maker by trade. At the library on the campus of the University of San Francisco, which is owned by the Catholics, there are two thick volumes on the Sanfords of New England. To make the connection with the abovenamed Daniel Sanford is the problem; which requires some research.

Abbie Sanford (McGuire) was the daughter of Sally Kaniaulono Adams and Daniel Sanford. She was born in Lahaina, Maui, and was educated on Maui at Maunaloa Seminary. She later married Joseph McGuire. Nine children were born to them: Evelyn, John, Marjorie, Mary, Arthur, James, Abbie, Lucy, and Charles.

Evelyn McGuire Jellings, daughter of Abbie Sanford, was born and educated in Honolulu. She was a practical nurse. She married William F. Jellings and had seven children: Cornelia (Quintal), Elizabeth, Sarah, William, Arthur, Joseph, and Marjorie.

Cornelia Jellings Quintal, daughter of Evelyn McGuire, was born and educated in Honolulu. In 1920 she married Frank Quintal. Five children were born: Frank, Jr., Evelyn, Lucille, Hazel May, and Bellie-Jean.

Elizabeth Jellings Lawrence, daughter of Evelyn McGuire, was born and educated in Honolulu; later graduated in a California hospital for nurses. In 1932 married Joseph Lawrence, a mining engineer. Now resides in Calif.

Sarah Jellings Booth, daughter of Evelyn McGuire, was born and educated in Honolulu. Worked as telephone operator and later married Harold Booth, a fireman. The children are Harold, Jacqueline and Newton.

William Kanehoa Jellings. Son of Evelyn McGuire was born and educated in Honolulu. He is a clerk for Castle & Cooke. He married Mary Ann Kapana and they have one child, Marilyn.

Joseph Jellings. Son of Evelyn McGuire was born and educated in Honolulu. Is a seaman; not married.

Marjorie Jellings (Sask). Daughter of Evelyn McGuire was born and educated in Honolulu. Graduated from McKinley High.

John McGuire. Son of Abbie Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. Later married Mary Kaihenui, and had one child: Katherine, in Hilo.

In 1915 he again married Keala and had five children: Evelyn (dead), Gladys Abel and two others who died young.

Katherine McGuire. Daughter of John McGuire, was born in Hilo and educated in Honolulu. Married Jacob Akiona in 1937 and had one daughter, who born April 20, 1938.

Marjorie McGuire Hustace. Daughter of Abbie Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. Is a stenographer in Honolulu and worked for the Hawaiian Legislator for a number of years. In 1916 married Harold Hustace and had two children, Harold, Jr. and Ethel Edean. Harold died at the age of two.

Marjorie later married again to Mr. Robert Mehrtens. Mr. Mehrtens is the president of General Motors of Honolulu.

Mary McGuire Hanchett. Daughter of Abbie Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. Later graduated from St. Mary's Hospital, Calif. Was a district nurse under Dr. A. K. Hanchett. Later she married Dr. Hanchett and had eight children: A. K., Jr. died in infancy, Lani, William, Ikua, Richard, Robert, (died young) Roberta and Harry. Married Dr. Rice and had one son, Frank. Again married Walter Chang - no issue. Is nurse on Molokai.

James McGuire. Son of Abbie Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. He later married Harriet Crowel and had one daughter. He divorced her and married again to Ella Ii and had three children: Donald (died young) Vernon and Herbert - and two more children: Arthur and June.

Abbie McGuire (dead) Daughter of Abbie Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. She married a pure Hawaiian man and had two children: George H. and a girl, Sally, who died young also Waikala.

Lucy McGuire Cockett. Daughter of Abbie Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu in 1923 married Kalani Cockett and have five children: Stella K., Josephine, Dorothea, Daylene, and Nathan.

Charles McGuire. Son of Abbie Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. In 1927 married Alice Wong and have two children: Kenneth Stacy and Leroy - died in infancy. Aug. 27, 1903 LeRoy was born.

Harriet Sanford Bergstrom (dead). Daughter of Sally Adams was born and educated on Maui. In 1880 married Olaf Bergstrom and had five children: Carl, Kathleen, twins (died) and George H. Mr. O. Bergstrom came from Sweden on one of the first whalers that came to Hawaii. Was captain of the first national guard in Honolulu. Was luna of the railroad company.

Carl F. K. Bergstrom. Son of Harriette Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. In 1926 married Violet Vera Cruz and have three girls: Ireta, Kathleen and Kalani. Also a boy, Olaf, who died at birth.

Ireta married Lawrence Cabral, and they have one son

Kathleen Bergstrom Markham Daughter of Harriette Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. In 1911 married John Markham and had one son, Alexander Fyfe and one adopted daughter, Luriel Aloha.

Alexander Markham. Son of Kathleen Bergstrom was born Oct 7 and educated at Kam School. In 1934 he married Pauline Laugier and a son was born to them: Alexander, Jr.

George Huen Bergstrom. Son of Harriett Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. In 1937 married Pearl Hubbard. No issue. Joined the Navy coast guard and was torpedoed by submarine and killed. He was chief engineer on ship.

George Huen Sanford. (father of Agnes Kauana Kanahele) . Son of Sally Adams and Daniel F. Sanford was born and educated in Waimea, Hawaii. Is an engineer. He married Emily Pae and had two children: Rose and George H. (dead) Later he married Julian Kaleikini and had four children: Kalani, Elizabeth, Agnes, and Daniel (dead). He married a third wife, Iday Feary. No children, only one adopted son, Billy.

Rose Sanford Pareno. Daughter of George Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. She married Mr. Pareno and have two girls - Elizabeth and Constance. Two more children were born later.

Elizabeth Sanford Schutte. Daughter of George Sanford was born and educated in Honolulu. In 1926 married Marcus Schutte and have five children: Harriet K. (6-6-1921); Marcus Jr. K (10-6-31), Henrietta K. (2-6-1930), Sanford (12-20-1933); Glorietta (7-18-39)

Agnes Sanford Kanahale Daughter of George Sanford, was born and educated in Honolulu. In 1929 she married Clinton Kanahale and seven children were born to them: George, Laura, Kauana, Albert, Edward, Ashley and Henry (or Wongie).

(When this record was made only George and Laura were the children)

Daniel Sanford Sr (dead. Son of Sally Adams was born in Honolulu. He married Lily Poepeo and had three children: Daniel, Jr., Henry and Cecelia who died young.

Daniel Sanford, Jr. was born in Honolulu. He married Emma Fililau and have three children: Elizabeth, Daniel and Auulei.

Henry Sanford. was born and ed. in Honolulu. He married Louisa Kaha'i. No issue.

Isaac Sanford. Son of Sally Adams married - no issue

Isaac Adams, Jr. Son of Isaac Keaumoku Adams, Sr., and Keliopunui was born at Niu, Oahu. He was educated in Hilo, Hawaii. He married Ana Kalili Kuoha. These children were born to them: Henrietta (died), Louise (died young) another Louise, Joseph, Mary and Isaac.

Louise Adams Jones Daughter of Isaac Adams. Born in Honolulu. Married John Jones - no children.

Joseph Adams. Born in Honolulu. Married Sophia Kahiwakumaka Pahia. They had seven children: William (died young), John, William, Joseph, Sophia, Pauline, and Evelyn.

Mary Adams Kahookele. Daughter of Isaac Adams. Born in Heeia, Oahu. She married David Kahookele and they had seven children: David, Ana, Edna, Hazel, Lono

Isaac Adams II Son of Isaac Adams I. Born in Honolulu. Married Minnie Kauwahikana. They had three children: Louise Kekahiliopauahi, Miriam, Isaac III *Kauwahikana*

David Adams (dead) Son of Isaac Keaumoku Adams, Sr. was born in Niu, Oahu He married Hannah Kawa. They had four children: Isaac Davis (d. young), Irene (died young) Maria and Fannie, Hannah (died) Wahinekipi (died)

Maria Uwaikikilani Adams Mitchell. Daughter of David Adams was born in Honolulu. She married John Mitchell and had four children: Bernice, Kathleen, Mildred (died young) and Edith Puaala.

Bernice Mitchell Kuhns. Born 22 May 1899, died 2 Feb 1957. Daughter of Maria Adams was born and educated in Honolulu. She married Lawrence Kuhns, and they have four children: Lawrence Emory Moanauli who married Hideko Takamine,

Vernon Konakai, Louetta Meliipunui, and a girl (died young).

Kathleen Michell Paakaula. Daughter of Maria Adams was born and educated in Honolulu. She married Jonah Paakaula and have three children: Solomon Kaliula (1924), Alatau Kawaiikilani (1927), Marion Aloha Jean who married Rudolph Babino in 1946. A daughter, Shirley Puakehaulani, born 1947 Others.

Puaala Michell Chang. Daughter of Maria Adams was born and educ. in Honolulu. She married James Chang. They had two children: Trewartha Keeaumoku and Kertya Honiala.

Fannie Adams Oana (dead) Daughter of David Adams was born in Honolulu. She married Charles Oana and they had ten children: Rachel, Henry, Alexander, Stanley, Frank, Caroline (John, Winifred, a girl, and a boy; all died young) Charles Oana died and Fannie married his brother Alfred and two children were born to them: Mildred and Arthur (Kawai)

Henry Oana Son of Fannie Adams was born on Maui. He married Ethel Stevens and they had two children: Stephen.

Rachel Oana Kaiama. Daughter of Fannie Adams was born and ed. on Maui. She married George Kaiama. Four children were born: Winifred, Bernice, Everett, Edward, Marvin (adopted by Alexander Adams) Gwendolyn, Arthur Allen

Alexander Alike Oana. Son of Fannie Adams was born and ed. on Maui. Married Ivy Yong (half C and half H) and had daughter Edith Nani, Alexander Alike and adopted son Merwin (son of Rachel and George Kaiama)

Stanley Manaia Oana married Elizabeth Leialoha Kanoho and they had Stanley, Eleanor Leinaala, Rossiter Kamealoha, Flora Leialoha

Carolina Kula Oana married John K. Fali and had Randall (died), John (d) Dianne Leipuaonalani, Charles Kalikiola (d), Rogers Leslie, Geraldine Kamaile, Ronald Leroy, Janet Kapuana, Alanjane Leiona

Lillian Kao Lekoolani (dead) Daughter of Sally Adams was born and ed. in Honolulu She married Charles Kekoolani and had nine children: Charles (d), Sara, Nawai, Pearl, Lillian, George, Aina, Bertha and Lucy.

Sara Kekoolani Makkekau was born on Hawaii. She married David Makkekau and seven children: David Jr., Albert, Clifford, Barbara, Marjorie, Violet, David Hartwell

Nawai Kekoolani was born and ed. on Hawaii; married Emily Hussey.

Pearl Kekoolani (d) was born and ed. on Hawaii Married Theodore E. Simmons and four children were born: Pearl, Theodore, Leslie and Adeline.

Lillian Kekoolani (d) was born and ed. on Hawaii. Married William W. Kaaikaula and had once child: Clinton Sherwood.

Captain Alexander Adams was born in Scotland Dec. 27, 1780 and educated in England. His father was earl of Fyfe. He died Oct 27 1871.

He married Mululi Ili Akalani and had one son, Alexander Napunako.

Alexander Napunako was born in Honolulu, and ed. in Hawaii. Was a captain. Married Hio and had two children: Maria and Beke.

Charlotte Steward Duval 1902 Daughter of Caroline McKeague was born and ed. in Honolulu. Is a stenographer. In 1926 married Albert Duval (French) and have two children: Albert Jr., Caroline Jane.

Kuulei Steward Akina 1909. Daughter of Caroline McKeague was born and ed. in Honolulu. Is a school teacher Two children: Maryann and Barbara Jean (adopted)

Robert M. McKeague 1884 Son of Mary Hio, was born and ed. in Honolulu. In 1912 married Label Marvin. Is a minister of Seventh Day A. church here.

Maria Kaleialii Webling 1892. Daughter of Mary Hio was born and ed. in Honolulu. In 1912 married Gus Webling. Is a school teacher. No issue.

Hattie Kaleialii Thompson 1902 Daughter of Mary Hio was born in Honolulu In 1923 married Duncan Thompson. Four children came to them: Duncan, Henry, Daniel and Caroline.

Robert Stone Bowd, Sr. (d) Son of Beke Adams was born in Honolulu. Later married Miss Williams. Five children: Rebecca, Annie, Robert Jr. (Robert Napuka-ko sent to Italy with Robert Wilcox in 1881 by King Kalakaua to get military education, became a surveyor), Victor and Alexander (d. young)

**Mary auld was the daughter of Andrew Auld, native of Linlithgow, Scotland, born Sept. 8, 1799 who came during the time of Kam I. He and Capt. Alexander Adams were old cronies for years in Kalini, Honolulu. Both men have a common grave and tombstone in Mauuanu, which reads: Alexander Adams, native of Arbroth, Forfarshire, Scotland. Born Dec. 27, 1780 Died Oct. 27 1871. Andrew Auld, native of

Linlithgow, Scotland Born Sept 8, 1799 Died Oct 26 1873. (Ref. Star Bulletin Feb 2 1939 p. 11 in Archives)

Sarah Adams Daughter of Captain Alexander Adams was born in Honolulu. Married George Train Gray. Six children were born to them. First three died in infancy. Alexander II born 1872, died 1897; Jennie Gray born 1875 married _____ and living; Barbara born 1874, widow, and living on Kauai.

Jennie Gray Daughter of Sarah Adams was born on Maui. Married Thomas Kiakona and two children were born to them: Boy, died young; and Thomas Gray, 1906.

Barbara Gray. Daughter of Sarah Adams was born on Maui. Married Henry G. Spaulding. One child was born to them: Mira 1914 living.

Victoria Adams Daughter of Captain Alexander Adams was born in Honolulu. Married Andrew Bannister. Six children were born to them: Mary 1862 married and living; Victoria 1863 married and living; Elizabeth 1865 married and living; Abbie 1866 married and living; Sarah 1868 married and living Andrew 1871 married and living.

Mary Bannister. Daughter of Victoria Bannister born in Honolulu and educated by the English Sisters. Married Charles Lucas. They had four children: James 1886 Honolulu, died at age 16; Charlotte 1888 Honolulu married and living; Charles 1890 Honolulu married and living; Mary 1891 Honolulu married and living.
